Concrete Block Retention with the following restriction below:

- Concrete Block Retention shall be designed by the vendor at each specific location in accordance with information provided in the Final Drainage Report produced under that specific project. Vendor shall provide stamped drawings and stamped calculations submittal to the Project Manager for review. These stamped submittals shall be done by a New Mexico Professional Engineer.
- If a Final Drainage Report is not provided on the project the vendor shall be responsible for a Drainage Report for design of the Concrete Block Retention. This drainage report and retention design shall be done by a New Mexico Professional Engineer. Vendor shall provide stamped drawings, stamped calculations, and stamped Drainage Report submittal to the Project Manager for review.
- Any Drainage Report produced by the vendor shall be in accordance with the current version of the NMDOT Drainage Design Manual.
- No work related to the Concrete Block Retention manufacture or construction shall begin on a project until approval has been obtained by the Project Manager.

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
