Bridge Reconstruction in San Jose

LAS VEGAS – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District Four will begin a Bridge Reconstruction Project on New Mexico Frontage Road 2116, mile post 14.5 over the Pecos River. The project will begin on Wednesday, November 11th 2020 and conclude in the Spring of 2021. Motorists should be advised that the bridge will be closed and detour routes will be in place. Northbound travelers should utilize Exit 319 (San Juan/ San Jose) and Southbound travelers should utilize Exit 323 (Villanueva).
