Effective immediately, the following IDD shall be used to ensure consistency in the project development process for all NMDOT projects in relation to project certification expiration timelines. The Project Development Engineer ("PDE") shall utilize the information below to ensure all project certifications are valid at the time of project production.

- Environmental: Certification expires after two (2) years from date of issuance.
- Right-of-Way: Certification does not expire unless the project requirements change and/or new Right of Way rights become required for the construction, operation or maintenance of the project.
- Railroad: Certification expires after one (1) year from date of issuance.
- ITS: Certification expires after one (1) year from date of issuance.
- Utility: Certification expires after six (6) months from date of issuance.
