NOTICE TO INTERESTED PARTIES
STATE FY 2021 LOCAL MATCH ASSISTANCE FOR VEHICLE CAPITAL REPLACEMENT
FOR EXISTING RECIPIENTS OF FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA) 49 USC SECTIONS
5307 AND 5311 FUNDS

The New Mexico Department of Transportation Transit and Rail Division announces the availability of \$600,000 in state funding to assist existing Section 5307 and 5311 public transportation providers with the replacement of aging vehicle fleets. These state funds can be used to meet up to 50% of the local match required for Federal funds.

The Transit and Rail Division is now accepting letters of application for these funds. Funds will be distributed among large urban, small urban, and rural public transportation operators.

Priority will be given to the replacement of vehicles that have exceeded their useful life benchmarks and are in poor condition.

All funds must be expended in State Fiscal Year 2021, ending June 30, 2021.

Letters of Application must include:

1. Organization Name, Address, Telephone Number, and Website information
2. Name, phone number, e-mail address, and title of the contact person submitting the application
3. The amount of funding requested, and
4. An itemized list of vehicle assets to be replaced, including condition ratings and useful life benchmarks exceeded, estimated costs and local match requirements
